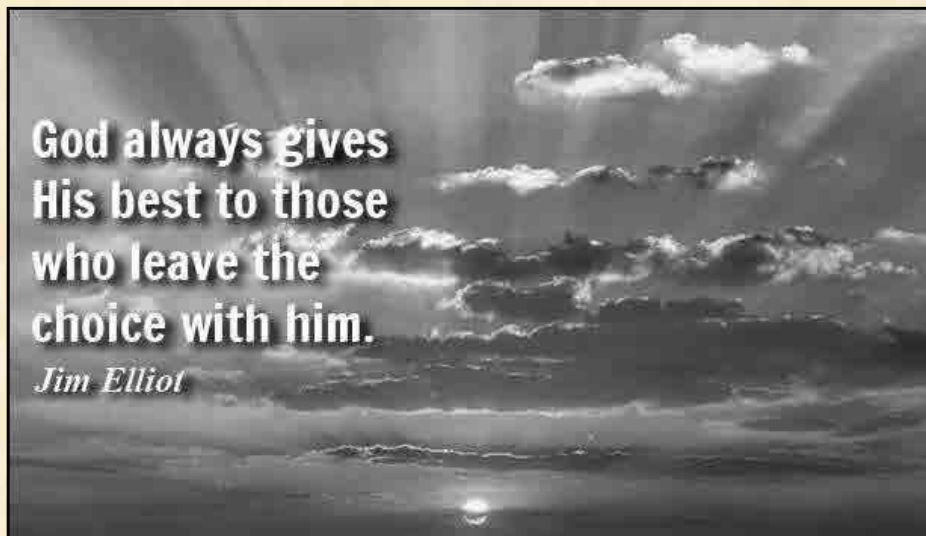
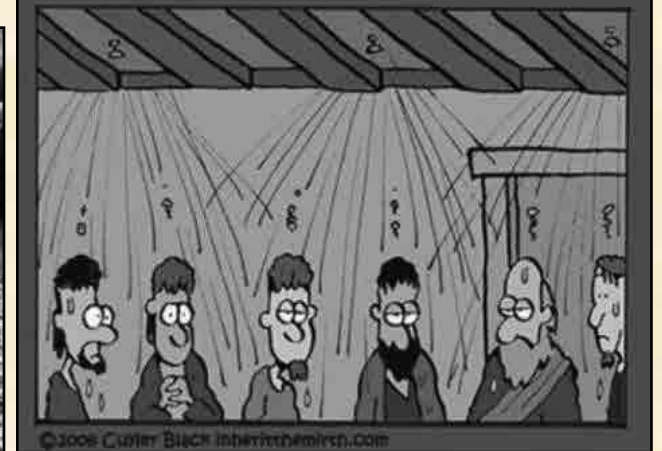
When I asked my friend if she was planning to attend church, she just shook her head.

## SERMON FOR FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Jesus the Good Shepherd wants you to not only to live, but also to have the best life possible. After He left this world, Jesus fulfilled His promise to help you live a good life by sending down the third Person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit. St. Peter said, "You will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is made to you and to your children and to all those far off, whomever the Lord our God will call."

God has called you to receive the Holy Spirit. But how do you know you have the Holy Spirit? St. Paul wrote in Galatians 5:22-23 that you have the Holy Spirit if your life shows these nine attitudes called "the fruits of the Holy Spirit." If you claim to be a Christian, others should see these attitudes in your daily living. Let's see what they are....

God gave me a visual aid last week to help explain the fruits. I found this picture on the floor at the Beechmont Goodwill Store that beautifully explains how all the fruits work together. When I saw it I exclaimed to myself, "Thank you Jesus! You just gave me the sermon for next week ...and for only 6 dollars!" I then asked Jesus if I could take up a second collection to defray the cost. There will be no second collection.

The first and most important fruit of the Holy Spirit is LOVE. Remember that old song, "They will know we are Christians by our Love." All the other fruits branch out from the center hub of love, like spokes on a bicycle wheel.

JOY is Love's strength because I can endure anything when I know that God Loves me.

PEACE is Love's security because I know that God will fight my battles...and win.

LONG SUFFERING is Love's patience because I know that everything happens for a reason. By patient waiting, God will show me what I must learn from my suffering.

GENTLENESS is Love's conduct because I should treat others the way I want them to treat me. I should not judge others just because they sin differently than I do.

GOODNESS is Love's character because I want to repay God's goodness to me by showing His Goodness to others. I should always act by wanting to do the highest good for another.

FAITH is Love's confidence because when I commit myself to God, He will make all things work to the good for the one who believes.

MEEKNESS is Love's humility because I, a sinner, don't deserve all the blessings God gives me.

TEMPERANCE is Love's victory because I win every time I overcome sin and follow God's Will that will give me the most abundant and best life possible. Like wheel of a bicycle, we have come full circle. All the fruits are connected together to the hub of LOVE.

I close with a Holy Spirit joke....

There was a boy riding his bike outside a church. The preacher saw him and told him to come into the church and get filled with the Holy Spirit. The boy said, "Preacher, someone might steal my bike." The preacher replied, "The Holy Spirit would take care of it." The preacher laid hands on the boys head.
