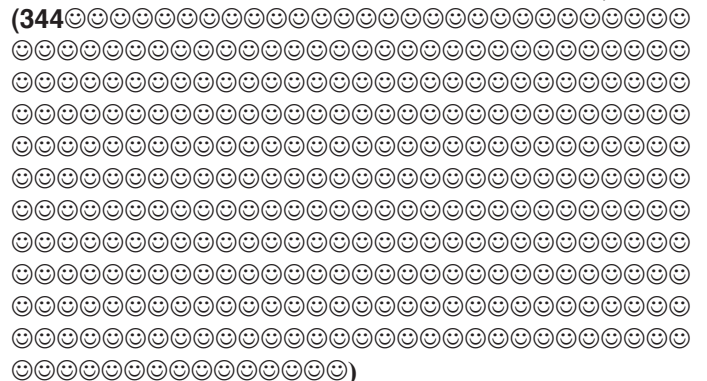

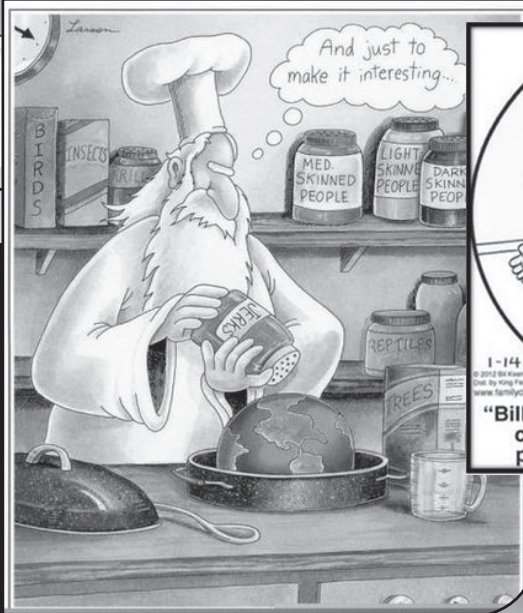

# *Pentecost Sunday Sermon*

There is a scene in my favorite Christmas movie that explains how the Holy Spirit works in our lives. Remember the lighting scene from *National Lampoon's Christmas Vacation* starring Chevy Chase. He plays the bumbling Clark Griswold who thinks he's so cool but messes up everything he does. He wants to impress his family so he installs like a gazillion lights on his house to celebrate the Christmas Spirit. The family gathers outside for the glorious lighting ceremony. With his wife Ellen doing a drum roll, Clark connects the cords...and nothing happens. He gets so angry he karate chops all the reindeer and kicks the plastic Santa Claus out of his sled. The family returns inside disappointed, thinking he has gone nuts. Clark failed again. While he checks out the wiring, Ellen figured out that all the cords are going into about 25 adapters connected to one socket in the garage that is controlled by a light switch. Under normal circumstances that would either throw the breaker or burn the house down, but this is a movie. There is a dramatic scene where at the exact moment, Clark plugs in the two extension cords, Ellen throws the switch. All the lights go on, lighting up the entire block. The family comes back outside to rejoice in what they see.

Each of you are a light bulb for the Lord. Jesus calls you to light up His Spirit that is inside of you. I call that "Jesus Light." You received the Holy Spirit in Baptism. Then the Holy Spirit gave you all His power in Confirmation. But in order to shine the Jesus Light within you, you have to get the power to do it from the Holy Spirit. Like in the movie, you have to turn the light switch on. How do you do this?

A good way to flick that switch on is to keep God's commandments. Here are the Ten Commandments as told by our country folk:

- 1.) Just one God.
- 2.) Ain't nothing come before the Lord.
- 3.) Quit your foul mouthin'.
- 4.) Git yerself to Sunday meetin'.
- 5.) Honor yer Ma & Pa.
- 6.) No killin', except critters.
- 7.) No foolin' around with another feller's woman.
- 8.) No tellin' tales and gossipin'
- 9.) No swipin' your kin folks stuff
- 10.) Don't be hankerin' for it neither.

As good as the Ten Commands are, Jesus chose one special light He wants you to turn on. This light more than all the others shows who God really is. That light is forgiveness. There are only two types of forgiveness in the Bible: God forgives our sins, and we forgive other's sins. This is so important that our eternal destiny depends upon it. Since we receive forgiveness from God, we have to give forgiveness to those who hurt us. The Light of Jesus and the Holy Spirit will shine brightest through you when you do that. Forgiveness is the best way to witness the Jesus Light. And when you go for your final judgement, that same amount of Jesus Light you shined on others will then be turned around to shine on you. Then even the angels in Heaven will rejoice at what they see. At Pentecost, the Holy Spirit gave the power to shine the Jesus Light. You have that power in your soul. Flick the switch, turn it on, shine it bright. Blessings...Fr. Mike
