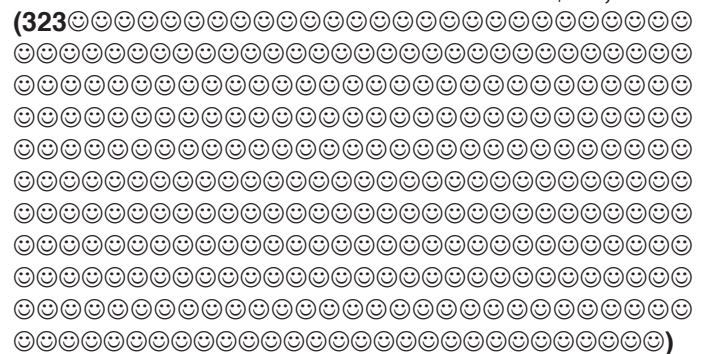

### ST. MARY VBS

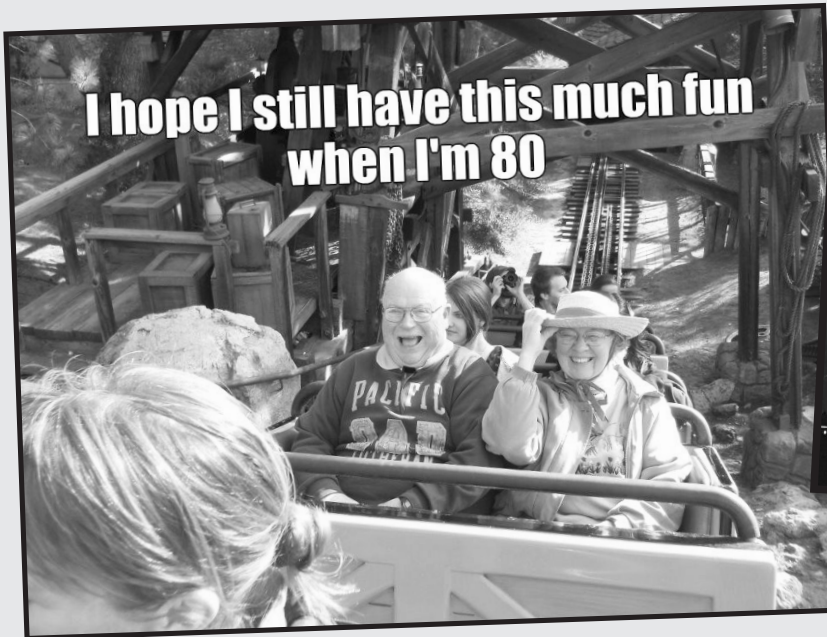
