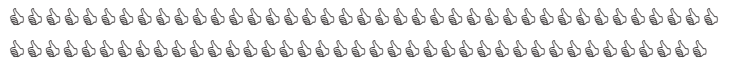

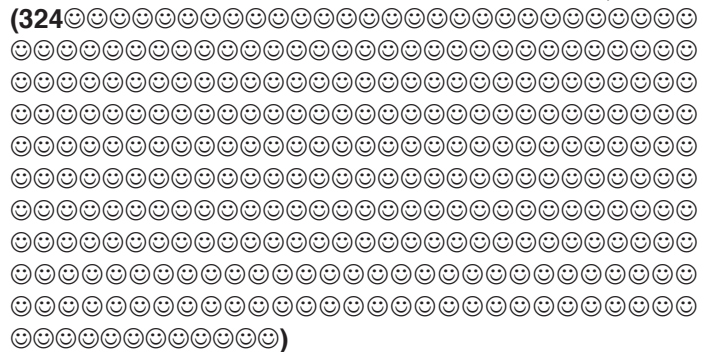

FR. MIKE'S SERMON FOR THE TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

If I asked you today, "Is Jesus the Christ, the anointed One from Heaven?" you would answer "yes." If I asked you, "Is Jesus the Son of God?" you would answer "yes." If I asked you, "Is Jesus King of the Kingdom of God?" you would answer "yes." Then you would wonder why I am asking such obvious questions about who Jesus is. To answer yes is no big deal. We already believe these things.

But it *is a big deal*. Your belief in "who Jesus is" is knowledge that comes directly from God the Father to you. That is why "faith" is called a "theological virtue" meaning that you can't get it on your own, but is given to you only by God. When Jesus asked His disciples, "But who do you say that I am?" He was fishing around to see if His Father revealed to any of them His true identity. Lo and behold, Jesus learned that the Father zapped Peter who knew Jesus was the "Christ of God." Jesus even told Peter that "this was not revealed to you by man, but by my Father in Heaven." (Matthew 16:15-17) I think Jesus was shocked that His Dad chose Peter of all people. Jesus knew Peter would blab His secret to everyone. Jesus went in to damage control. The Bible said He "scolded them" and "directed them not to tell this to anyone." Jesus was really angry.

But why was He angry? Why the secrecy? Jesus only told two people directly that He was the Christ (in Hebrew called Messiah) – the five-time married woman at the well and the man born blind whom others condemned as a sinner. Jesus never stood in the open market declaring publicly, "I am the Christ!" There are seven times in the Bible where Jesus commanded the disciples, the people He healed and even the demons to say nothing about His identity.

Jesus wanted secrecy because He knew no one but only His Father could reveal the true Jesus as the anointed Son who saves you by suffering, dying and rising. Consider this important fact. God the Father has chosen you to know Jesus. God has chosen you to know the true meaning of what Jesus did on the Cross as His supreme act of Love to you. After Jesus went back to Heaven, He sent down the Holy Spirit to you. You were chosen to possess this supernatural knowledge about God's Plan. The Holy Spirit supernaturally enabled you to believe it.

By this point in the sermon you should be feeling really special. And you are. Jesus told Peter he was blessed to know this secret about Him. Jesus calls you blessed as well. But don't get a big head over being chosen. Those who are chosen are also called. You are called to help others know Jesus as *their* Christ, their Anointed One who loves and forgives them. God has called you to help others accept Jesus as their personal Savior. How do you help others do that? The answer came to me by accident. When the church offered us the new Mass prayers in 2011, they changed the sending forth prayer. I tried to remember the new dismissal prayer, but I remembered it incorrectly. I accidentally put three of them into one. There is "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord" and "Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life" and simply just "Go in peace." My mind remembered it as "Go in peace and announce the Gospel by your life." Maybe the Lord inspired me to remember it this way because it challenges me to announce the Gospel by living it. I am called to live "God's Good News" by loving and forgiving and caring and affirming others just as Jesus did. Your call will cause you to suffer like Jesus did. Your life on earth is no longer your own. It is "Spirit powered" for God. You were chosen to proclaim the Gospel. Use words only when necessary. You are blessed.
